Please consider this formal written communication to the TVLC board ahead of the Thursday 2/25 board meeting. Per TVLC guidelines, all formal communication received before the board meeting should be acknowledged at the board meeting.

Please respond to the following items:

1. Where is the press release or communication regarding the alleged "missing" students? The only response I have seen was the acknowledgement of a meeting at Livermore City Hall with the promise that all parties are in agreement that these schools are in ok shape and should remain a part of the community. We have seen zero communication offering an explanation as to WHERE the students actually where, WHEN they were there, and WHY they were there. WHO authorized their transfer to another school and what procedures were followed in advance of securing a transfer? Were the guardians of these two students part of this process? Sadly, the only formal communication received by LVCS families did not even acknowledge the main topic of the meeting at Livermore City Hall, so we are left again to go off of what the media reports. TVLC's communication policy requires timely communication to parents and it seems that it is missing during recent events.

2. What is the nature of the relationship between TVLC/LVCP/LVCS and the entity know as California International Academies of which Nina Stoien is/was the Executive Director of Operations? Are there any members of the leadership of California International Academies that are also members of the leadership of TVLC/LVCP/LVCS? If there is a relationship with California International Academies, please explain what this organization's corporate status and mission are and how the relationship meets the requirements of the TVLC charter.
