Dear TVLC BOD & Dr. Lysko,

Happy Friday! I trust you all enjoyed your long weekend. I'm writing today to request several ignored agenda items over the past weeks. I sincerely hope that our community sees these items for the June 9, 2016 agenda.

- Financing of the parking lot.
 - While it was promised that we would pay nothing, the public needs to know if our “co-tenant” AKA, our former CEO Bill Batchelor, and his business partners, made that designated donation upfront or if it was another “handshake deal” with a promise to pay once bills are due.
 - If the donation has already been deposited, then the public will need proof of that.
 - If there is no written agreement for payment of the parking lot, will more ADA state money be diverted from classrooms to pay for a parking lot on land that TVLC does not own and that several stakeholders expressed they did not want at this time?
- Budgets for each school and for TVLC.
 - State budgets are due June 30. Yet, those budgets need to go through committees, site councils and for approval to the BOD before that date. When will CSMC have those budgets available for review?
- CCEF
 - My understanding is that CCEF is designed to fund raise for the following calendar year. CCEF only began withholding funds in April. Where did the money go that was given last year for the 15-16 school year? Since these are designated funds, where is the accounting? If TVLC is having trouble with payroll, it shouldn't be for the specialists who CCEF already paid for.
- Hearings for the Removal of Mr. Lessard
 - You've heard from several stakeholders. LVCS Council spent countless hours on this document. If Mr. Lessard is so confident about his seat on the board, allow the hearings to take place and let the facts speak for themselves.
 - Not included in the 11d findings of LVCS Council are now additional actions like ignoring the directive to hold the first Audit Committee meeting. I've already sent a letter about that on May 20, 2016, so I encourage you to refer to it.
 - I'd like to also remind Mr. Lessard that he can save everyone a lot of time and energy and simply do the honorable thing by acknowledging his nullification per the LVCP vote on April 25, 2016. I believe Mr. Weiss's exact words after that vote were:

“Motion passed that Scott Lessard is not our LVCP Council Representative.”

- Revoking or ending all contracts with Bill Batchelor and his business associates.
 - The Acacia authorizers, NJESD, already asked for this. How many could be illegal? How many benefit the corporation vs. benefit CPA and other business entities known to have associations with Bill Batchelor?
- Correct the documented potential Brown Act Violations

- The clock is ticking on these. I'm wondering if the BOD would rather correct these potential violations or allow the District Attorney to do so?
- Investigate Government Code 1090
 - This seems like a very wise thing to do in the face of mounting costs of alleged predatory leases spoken of in the NJESD NOV written in April.
- Discussion AND Action on the CEO Performance Review
 - On May 11th, 2016, while speaking about needing board approval to pull the permits on the parking lot, Dr. Lysko stated she “Serves at the Pleasure of the Board” and that she can't do anything without board approval. She also stated that TVLC and only TVLC could pull those permits because TVLC is the landowner. I'm still not clear if she was not telling the truth or grossly misinformed. I'm not comfortable with a CEO who is either.
 - On May 12, 2016 she informed the BOD that TVLC sent the response to the NJNOV without Board approval. In that response, it clearly states that an audit committee has been formed. At that meeting in Stockton, I asked for clarification as Mr. Lessard set the date for the first meeting of the Audit committee and she told me the response said TVLC *would* be forming an audit committee. Again, I wonder, was this a bold mis-truth or grossly misinformed? You may refer to both the NOV Response and my letter dated May 20, 2016.
- Answers to teacher's questions submitted on April 19, 2016 at the joint LVCS & LVCP Council meeting.
 - Since LVCS teachers were told the week prior to April 19 that they may not receive a paycheck, they submitted a list of reasonable questions they had. To the best of my knowledge, none have been adequately answered. When do you plan on doing that?
 - Now CCEF has been told that TVLC is in “dire need” of funds that have been withheld since April. Could teachers be facing another threat to their next paycheck?
- Report on Reserve
 - Are we meeting the legal requirement that 3% reserve is held for each school.
 - What are the legal consequences if we are not?
 - What are the reserves at this time?

Thank you for your attention to the above matters. I look forward to seeing several if not all of these items on the June 9, 2016 agenda. And, I'd like to remind the board and Dr. Lysko that to the parents and the children, this is not a game. Please take the education of our children seriously and move forward in an ethical, honest and honorable manner.
