Subject: **Cure and Correct Follow-Up**

Dear Directors and Dr. Lysko:

I am writing as a follow-up to my e-mail from May 10. My correspondence on that date to you was to alert you to what I believe to have been a clear violation of the Brown Act and a request to cure or correct the violation. In accordance with the Brown Act, you have 30 days from the receipt of the demand to either cure or correct the challenged action or to inform me of your decision not to do so. This e-mail serves as a courtesy reminder that the deadline is fast approaching and I have not yet received any response regarding my original notice and have yet to see any action which would serve to correct what I have called out as a Brown Act violation. As a reminder, I will seek assistance from the District Attorney's office if the deadline passes without action.
