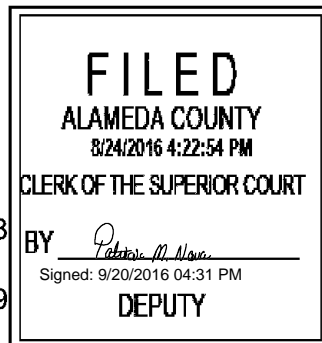

The undersigned, being sworn says, on information and belief, that BROCK VAN WEY did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about January 28, 2016, commit a MISDEMEANOR, to wit: ASSAULT AND BATTERY, a violation of section 242 of the PENAL CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) did willfully and unlawfully, having the present ability to do so, commit a violent injury on the person of John Doe and did use force and violence upon the person of John Doe.

SECOND COUNT

The undersigned further deposes and says on information and belief, that said BROCK VAN WEY did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about January 28, 2016, commit a MISDEMEANOR, to wit: CRUELTY TO CHILD BY ENDANGERING HEALTH, a violation of section 273a(b) of the PENAL CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) was a person having the care and custody of John Doe, a child of Fourteen years, who, under circumstances and conditions other than those likely to produce great bodily injury and death, did willfully cause and permit the person and health of said child to be injured, and did willfully cause and permit said child to be placed in such a situation that its person and health may be endangered.


THIRD COUNT

The undersigned further deposes and says on information and belief, that said Eric Dillie, Randy Taylor did, in the County of Alameda, State of California, on or about January 29, 2016, commit a MISDEMEANOR, to wit: FAILURE TO REPORT CHILD ABUSE, a violation of section 11166(c) of the PENAL CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) being a mandated reporter as described in Penal Code section 11165.7, and having knowledge of and having observed, in said defendant's professional capacity and within the scope of the defendant's employment, a child whom the defendant knew or reasonably suspected to be a victim of child abuse and neglect, did fail to report to an agency specified in Section 11165.9 the said incident of known or reasonably suspected child abuse and neglect.

Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1054.5(b), the People are hereby informally requesting that defendant's counsel provide discovery to the People as required by Penal Code Section 1054.3.
